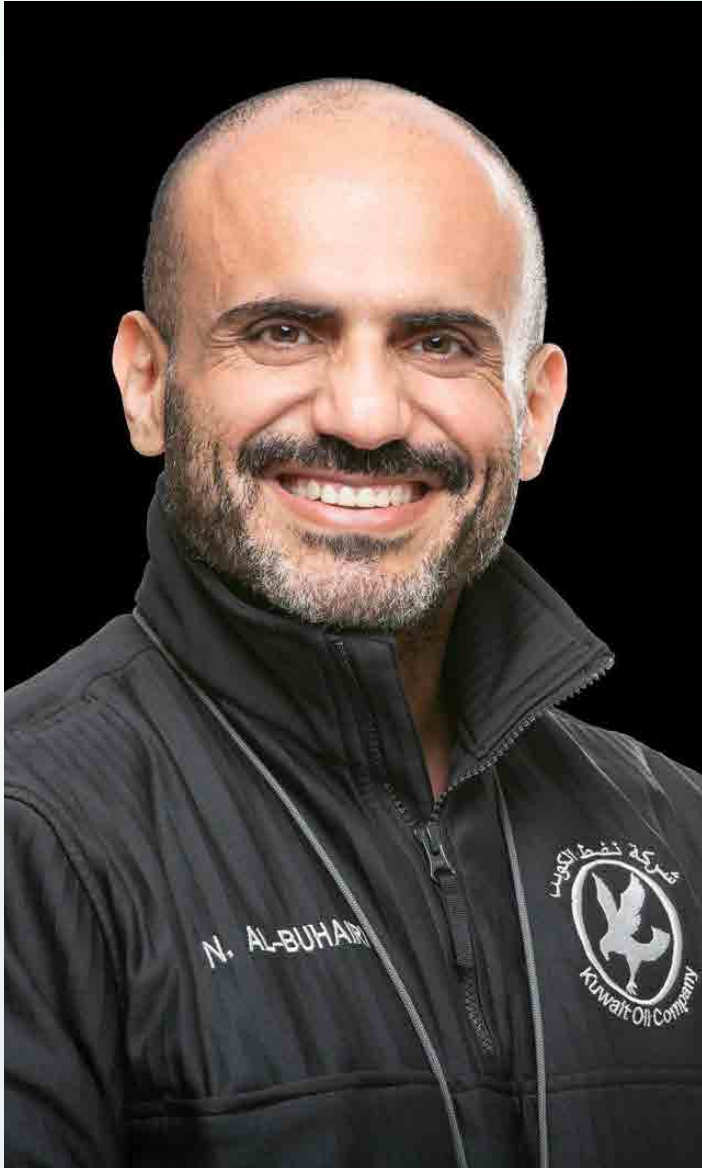

### Workshop Title: The Neuroscience of Safety Incidents

#### Workshop Description:

This interactive 3-hour workshop explores how neuroscience can deepen our understanding of workplace safety incidents. It focuses on how the brain and body respond to stress, fatigue, and risk—helping participants recognize human and neurological factors that contribute to safety lapses. The session equips participants with practical tools to strengthen attention, decision-making, and resilience in high-risk environments such as oil and gas.

#### Learning objectives:

- Explain how the brain perceives and responds to workplace hazards, stress, and risk signals.
- Recognize the impact of hormonal changes (e.g., cortisol and adrenaline) on alertness, focus, and safety behavior.
- Apply insights from Polyvagal Theory to understand how nervous system states affect communication, awareness, and reactions during safety-critical moments.
- Identify the effects of fatigue and mental exhaustion on decision-making and error likelihood in high-risk environments.
- Understand how sleep deprivation and irregular work patterns impair judgment and increase safety risks.
- Discuss key challenges in managing neurological risks and explore leadership practices that foster a brain-smart safety culture.

#### Learning Outcomes:

- » Understand the brain and hormonal mechanisms influencing safety behavior.
- » Recognize fatigue and stress as neurological precursors to safety incidents.
- » Apply brain-based strategies to improve focus, resilience, and situational awareness.
- » Identify leadership actions that foster a brain-smart safety culture.

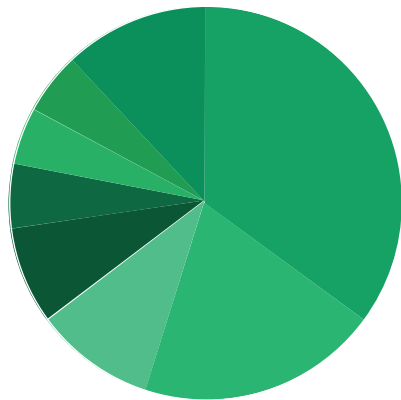
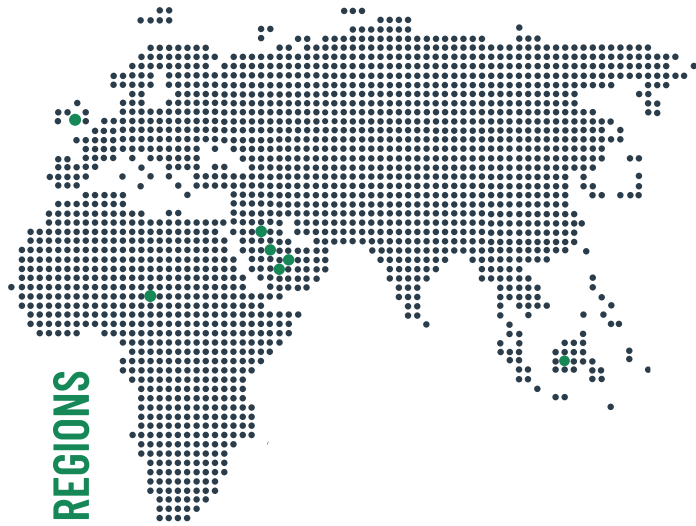
